PSED

Secure Explorers

Toddlers who are supported to form strong attachments, recognise familiar routines, and begin to understand their own feelings. They are gently encouraged to build early friendships, show care for others, and gain confidence to explore their environment knowing a trusted adult is close by.



C&L

Confident Communicators

Children are immersed in language through songs, stories, rhymes, and everyday conversation. They are encouraged to listen, respond, use gestures, signs, and emerging words to express needs, interests, and feelings.



PD

Active Movers

Toddlers develop strength, balance, and coordination through climbing, crawling, running, dancing, and outdoor play. Fine motor skills are supported through mark making, posting, stacking, pouring, and self-care routines such as feeding and dressing.



EAD

Creative Explorers

Toddlers experiment freely with paint, music, movement, role play, and sensory materials. They are encouraged to explore sounds, textures, colours, and actions, expressing ideas and emotions through play rather than finished outcomes.

LITERACY

Story Lovers

Children enjoy sharing books, exploring pictures, turning pages, and joining in with familiar stories and rhymes. They begin to make marks with crayons, chalk, paint, and natural materials, discovering that marks have meaning.



MATHS

Curious Counters

Through play, toddlers explore early mathematical ideas such as more and less, big and small, full and empty. They experience counting through songs, routines, and everyday play, and begin to notice patterns and shapes in their environment.



UTW

Little Discoverers

Children explore the world through sensory play, outdoor experiences, and real-life objects. They begin to notice changes in nature, explore cause and effect, and learn about themselves, their families, and familiar routines.
